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WHAT? The Social Language Summer Adventure Camp is an opportunity for children with social language impairments to have shared positive experiences with peers within therapist guided interactions both in and out of the clinic environment. Clinic sessions will focus on conversational skills, planning field trips, and problem solving any social or communication issues that may arise during field trips. Community excursions will be hosted by licensed, Speech-Language Pathologists with experience in teaching social skills and pragmatic language, and will focus on pro-social skills such as turn-taking, polite requesting, perspective taking, and interpreting nonverbal social cues.

WHO? 2-3 therapist-led groups, ages 6-8 & 9-12 (maximum 4-5 members per group)

WHEN? Series of 3 two-week sessions – (There are one-hour group sessions are at the SPG Clinic in Walnut Creek on Mondays and Wednesdays - precise times to be announced).

- **Session 1: June 21 – July 2 (Field Trips on 6/25 and 7/2)**
- **Session 2: July 6 – July 16 (Field Trips on 7/9 and 7/16)**
- **Session 3: July 19 – July 30 (Field Trips on 7/23 and 7/30)**

Field Trips scheduled on Fridays 10 a.m. – 12 noon.

WHERE? Field trip adventures may include: Miniature Golf at Boomers or Super Franks, Roller-skating at Golden Skate, Bowling, Lawrence Hall of Science, Heather Farms Picnic/Games, Private Lake Picnic/Games, & Swim Party

HOW MUCH? Each session is \$300.00; fee for all three is \$850.00. This includes two weekly therapy sessions, materials, and entrance fees.
